

# FUND UPDATE

## Maritime KiwiSaver Scheme

for the year ended 31 March 2018

### WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THIS UPDATE?

This document tells you how the fund has performed and what fees were charged. The document will help you to compare the fund with other funds. The Trustees of the Maritime KiwiSaver Scheme prepared this update in accordance with the Financial Markets Conduct Act 2013.

This information is not audited and may be updated.

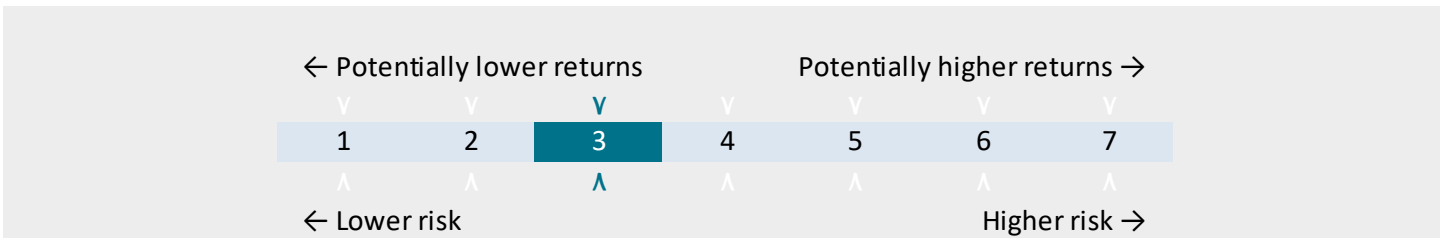
### DESCRIPTION OF THIS FUND

Invests in a wide range of assets, about 65% comprising growth assets such as shares and 35% comprising income assets such as bonds and cash. Suited to longer-term investors who want a diversified portfolio of assets with a high exposure to shares and other growth assets and are willing to accept more ups and downs than can be expected from the Conservative Portfolio.

### WHAT ARE THE RISKS OF INVESTING?

Risk indicator for the fund:



The risk indicator is rated from 1 (low) to 7 (high). The rating reflects how much the value of the fund's assets goes up and down. A higher risk generally means higher potential returns over time, but more ups and downs along the way.

Note that even the lowest category does not mean a risk-free investment, and there are other risks that are not captured by this rating.

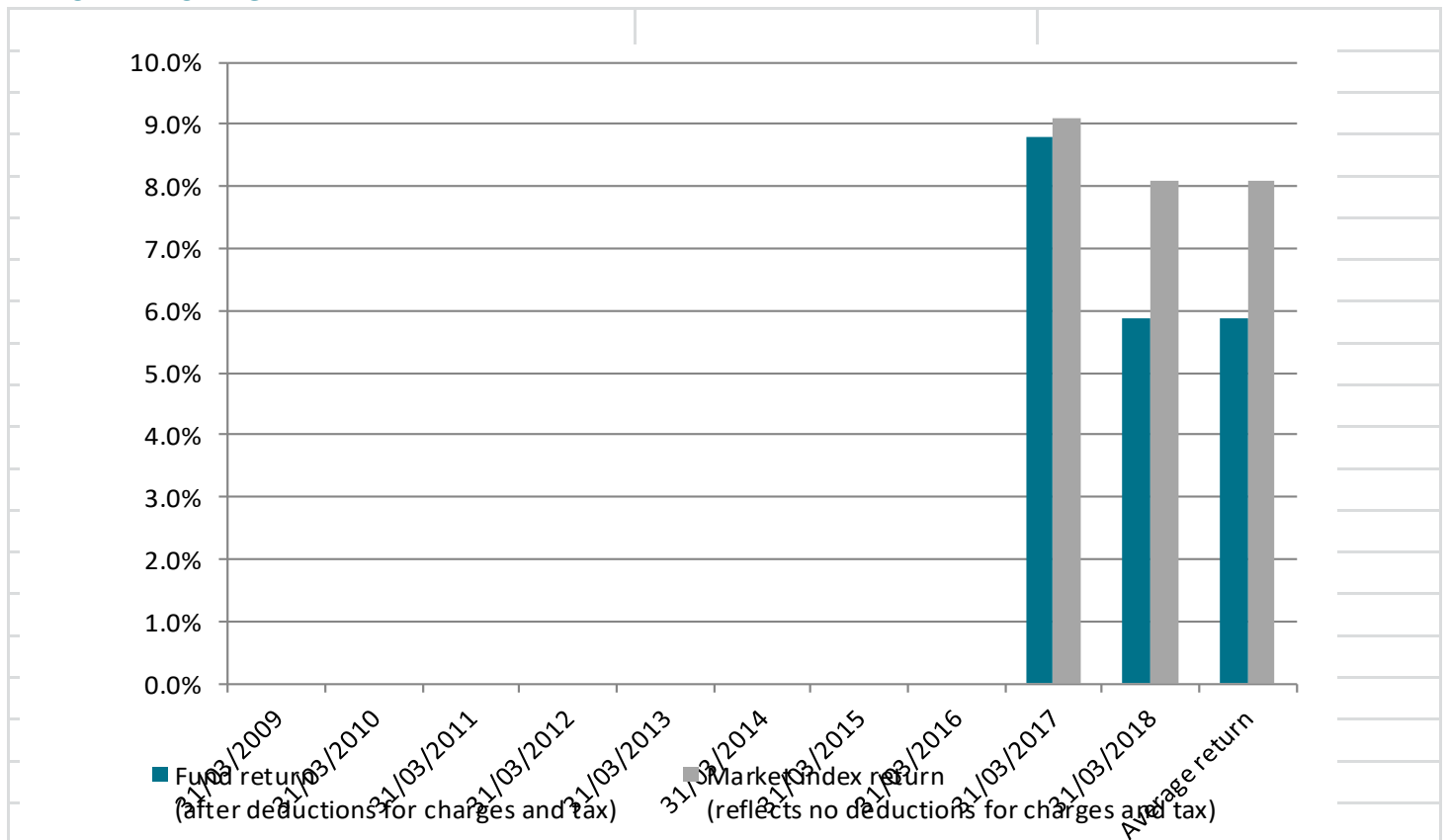

## HOW HAS THE FUND PERFORMED?

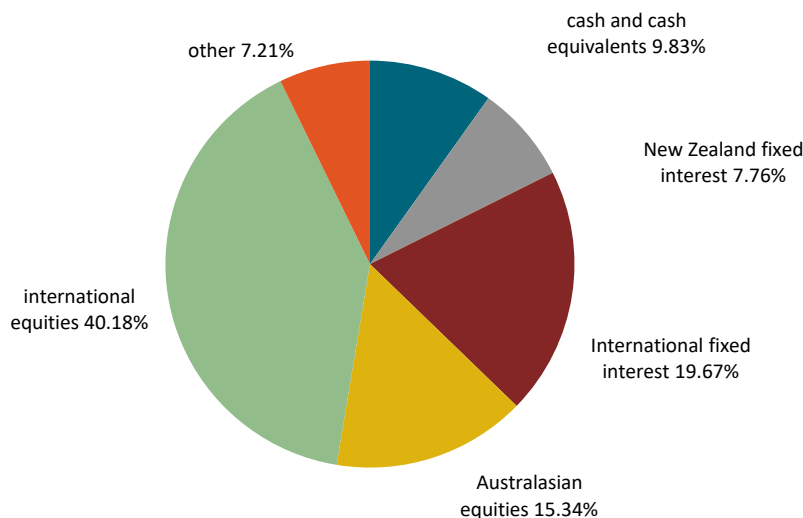
## EXAMPLE OF HOW THIS APPLIES TO AN INVESTOR

Brian had \$10,000 in the fund at the start of the year and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Brian received a return after fund charges were deducted of \$878.70 (that is 8.79% of his initial \$10,000. No other charges were deducted. This gives Brian a total return after tax of \$878.70 for the year.
